The Aims and Objectives of the FIA

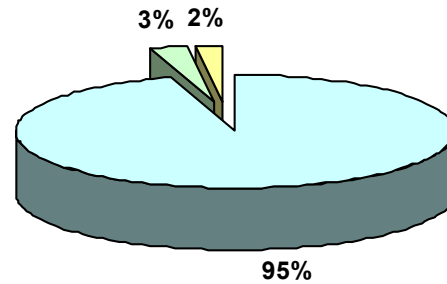
TO PROMOTE	The benefits and applications of fibre optic technology as an adjunct to - or as a replacement for - conventional copper communications technology

	Standards for the industry - both operational and ethical - to which members will be expected to adhere ensuring that the highest quality of service is provided

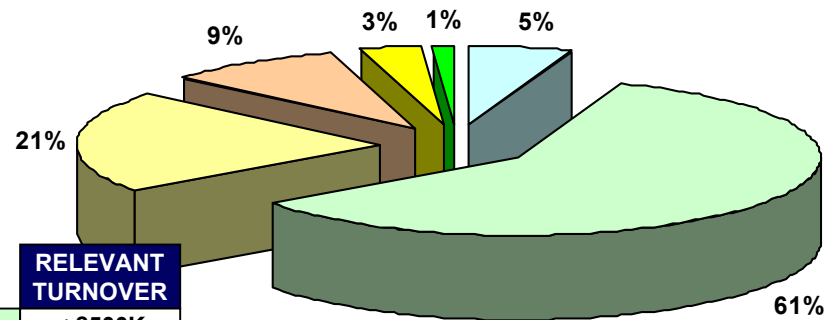

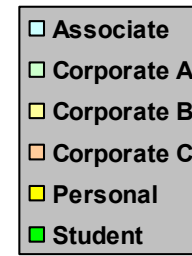

Membership by REGION



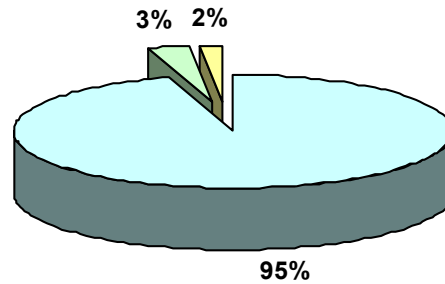
UK Membership Profile



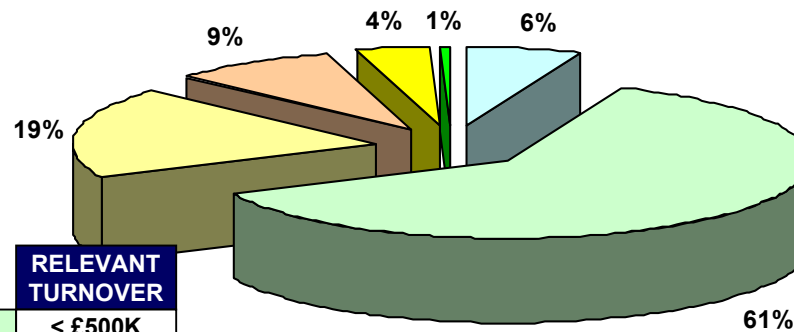

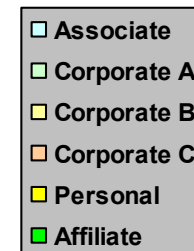

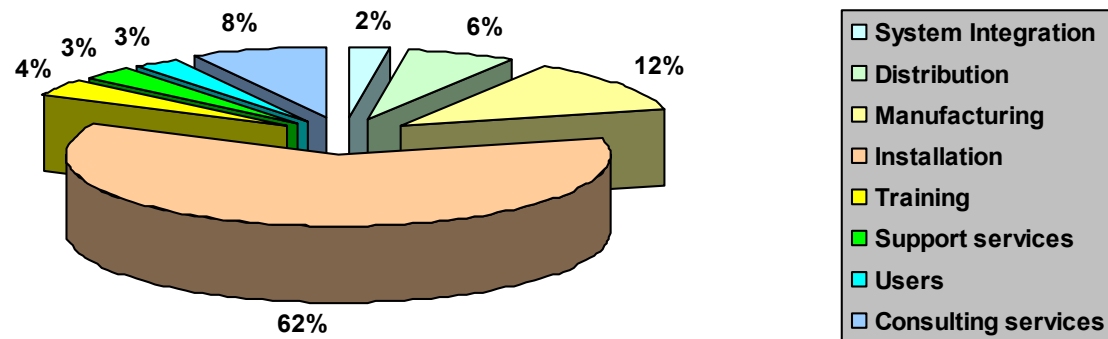

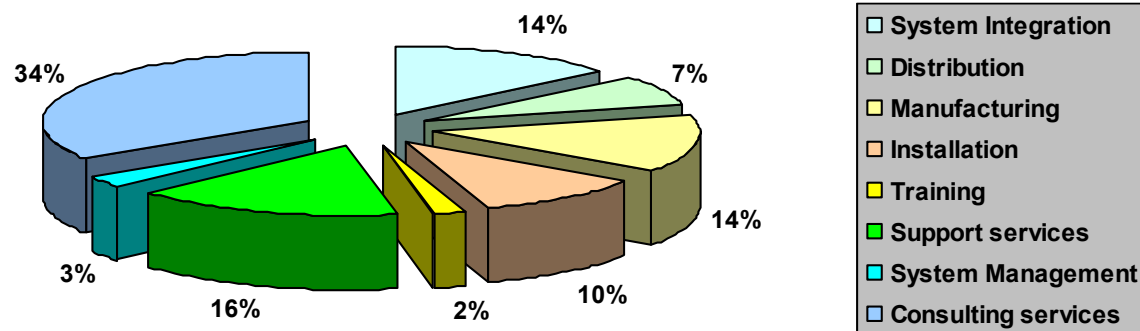
Membership Activity Profiles 04/04

Quoted PRINCIPAL ACTIVITY



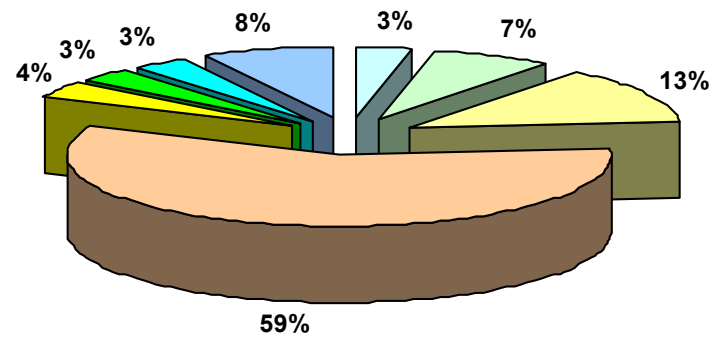
Quoted SECONDARY ACTIVITY



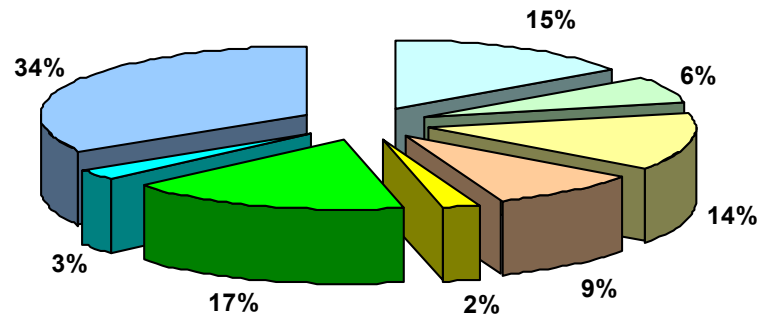

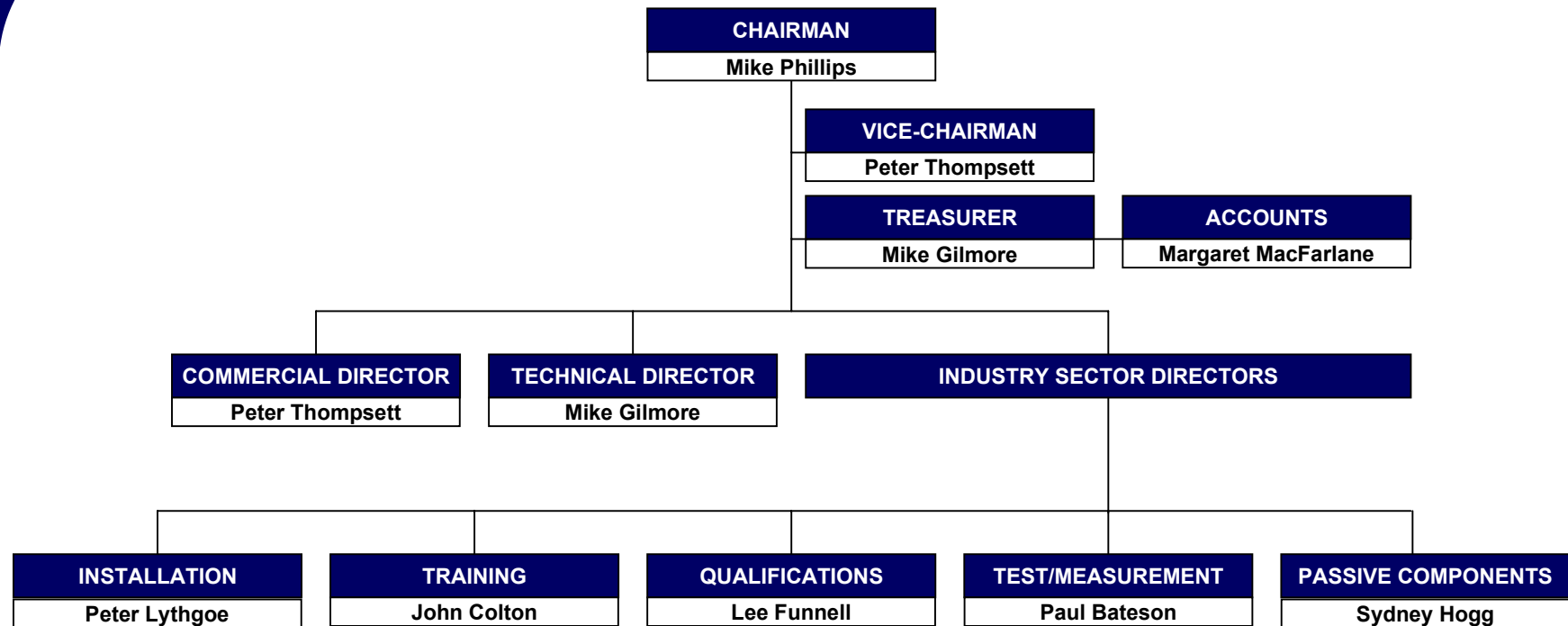
Quoted PRINCIPAL ACTIVITY

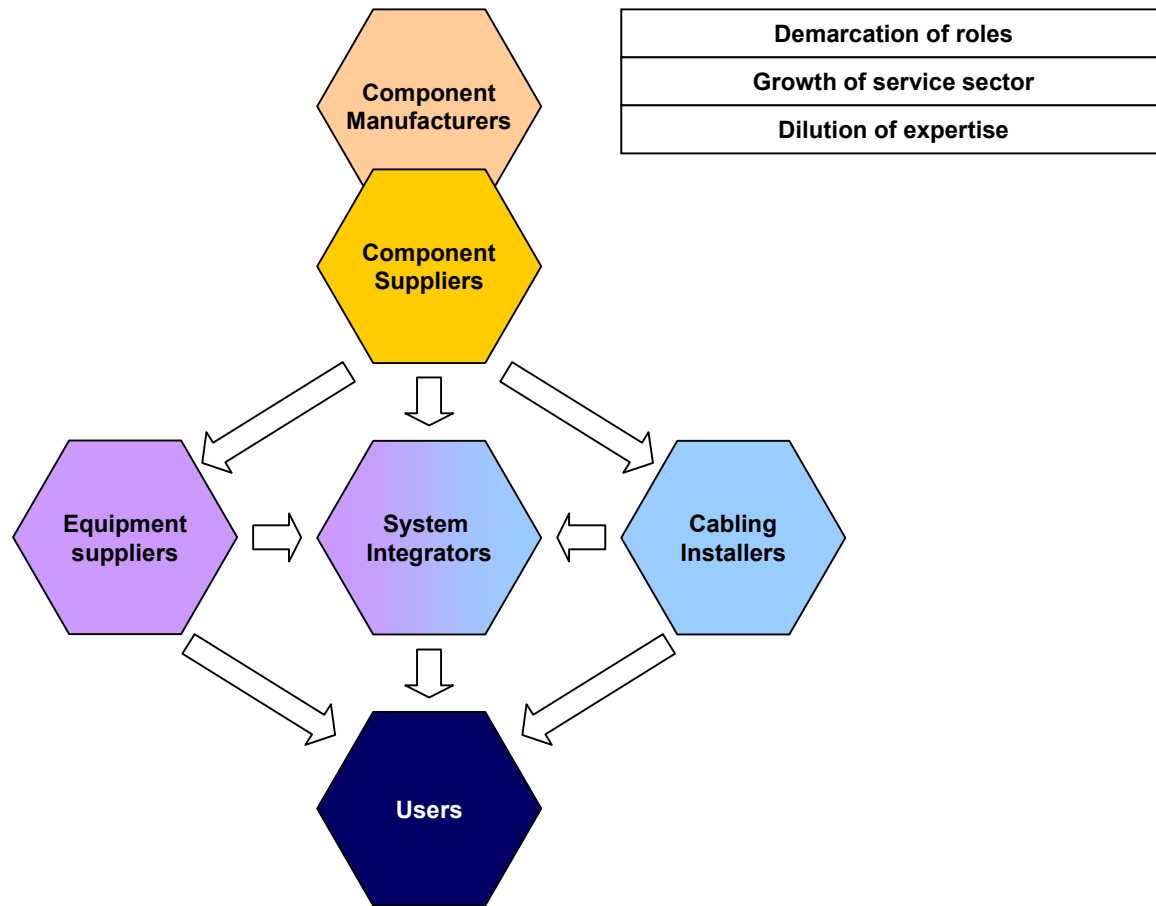

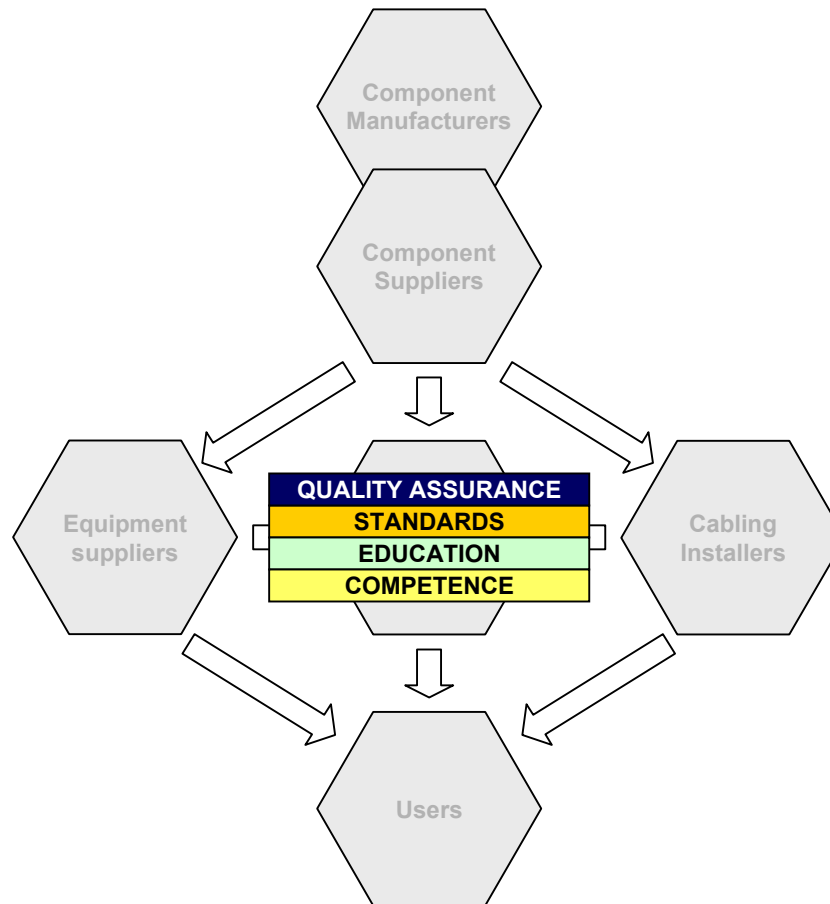

Roy began his duties as the editor of the FIA Newsletter with the production of issue 22 in June 1999 and he completed his last copy in October 2003 with Issue 73.

Thank you for all your hard work Roy and we wish you all the best for the future.

As is predicted it is worth pointing out that Roy was instrumental in the promotion of BS 7718 when it was published by the FIA, as an interim step, in 1991. Roy retired at a time when BS 7718 had just been withdrawn and replaced by a much stronger standard - BS 6701:2004 (see inside for details).
