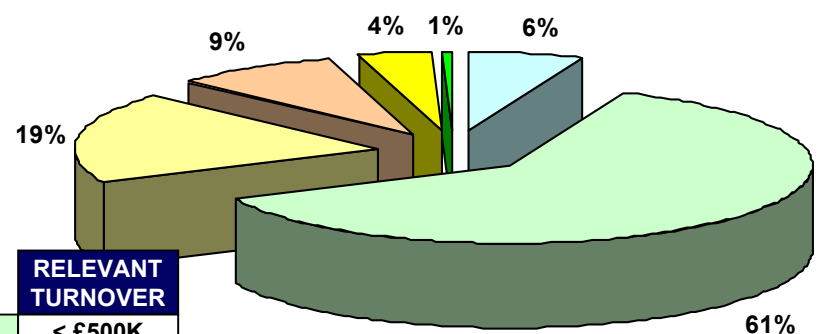

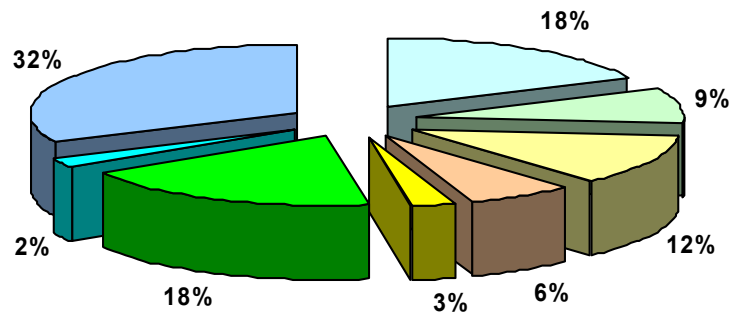

Quoted PRINCIPAL ACTIVITY

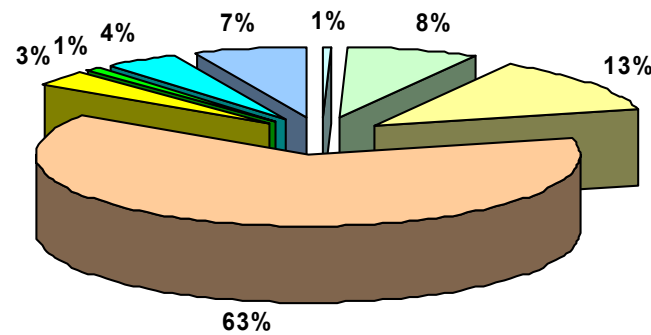


Quoted SECONDARY ACTIVITY

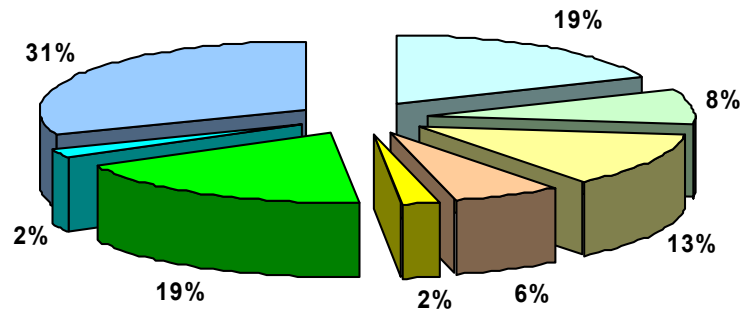

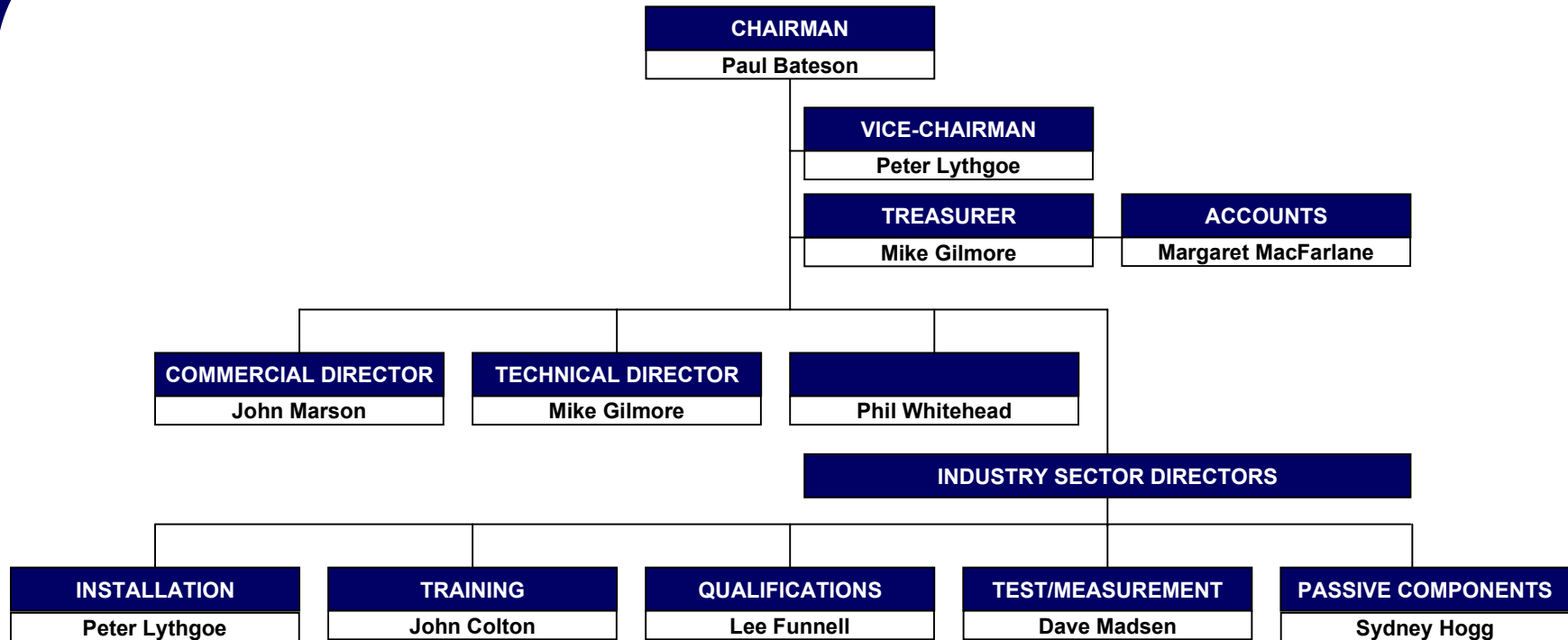

Roy Atterbury Steps Aside?
As we reported in the last Newsletter, Roy Atterbury has stepped down as the editor of the FIA Newsletter.
Roy started working as Secretary of FIA in December 1990 and provided service above and beyond the call of duty until he retired in December 1997 when the Secretarial function was transferred to Hanning Gibbons Ltd.
Roy began the duties as the editor of the FIA Newsletter with the production of issue 22 in June 1999 and he completed his last copy in October 2003 with Issue 73.
Thank you for all your hard work Roy and we wish you all the best for the future.
As is predicted it is worth pointing out that Roy was instrumental in the promotion of BS 7718 when it was published by the FIA, as an interim step, in 1991. Roy retired at a time when BS 7718 had just been withdrawn and replaced by a much stronger standard - BS 6701:2004 (see inside for details).
