Only trainers meeting FIA requirements for knowledge, training qualifications and experience will receive FIA Certified Trainer status, thereby being authorised to deliver and assess certain training courses for the purposes of the FIA Qualification Scheme. All trainers wishing to become FIA Certified Trainers must complete this Application Form detailing all relevant qualifications and experience. The FIA may request evidence of any details given on the Application Form.

The FIA will not accept applications from trainers with less than one years experience in the fibre optics, cabling or a closely related industry.
