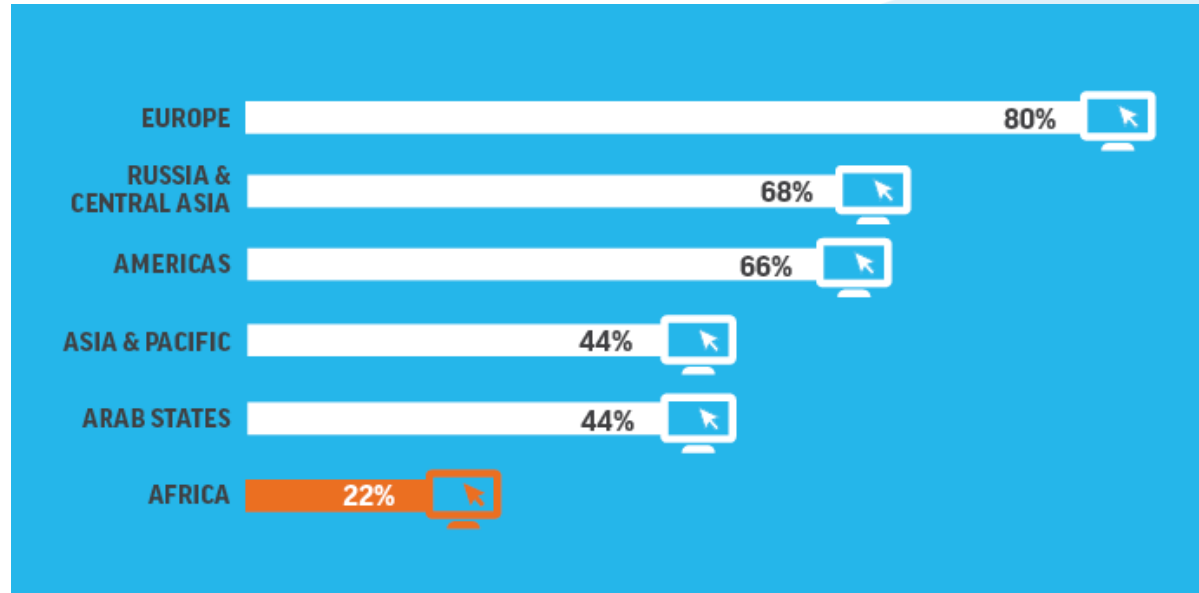
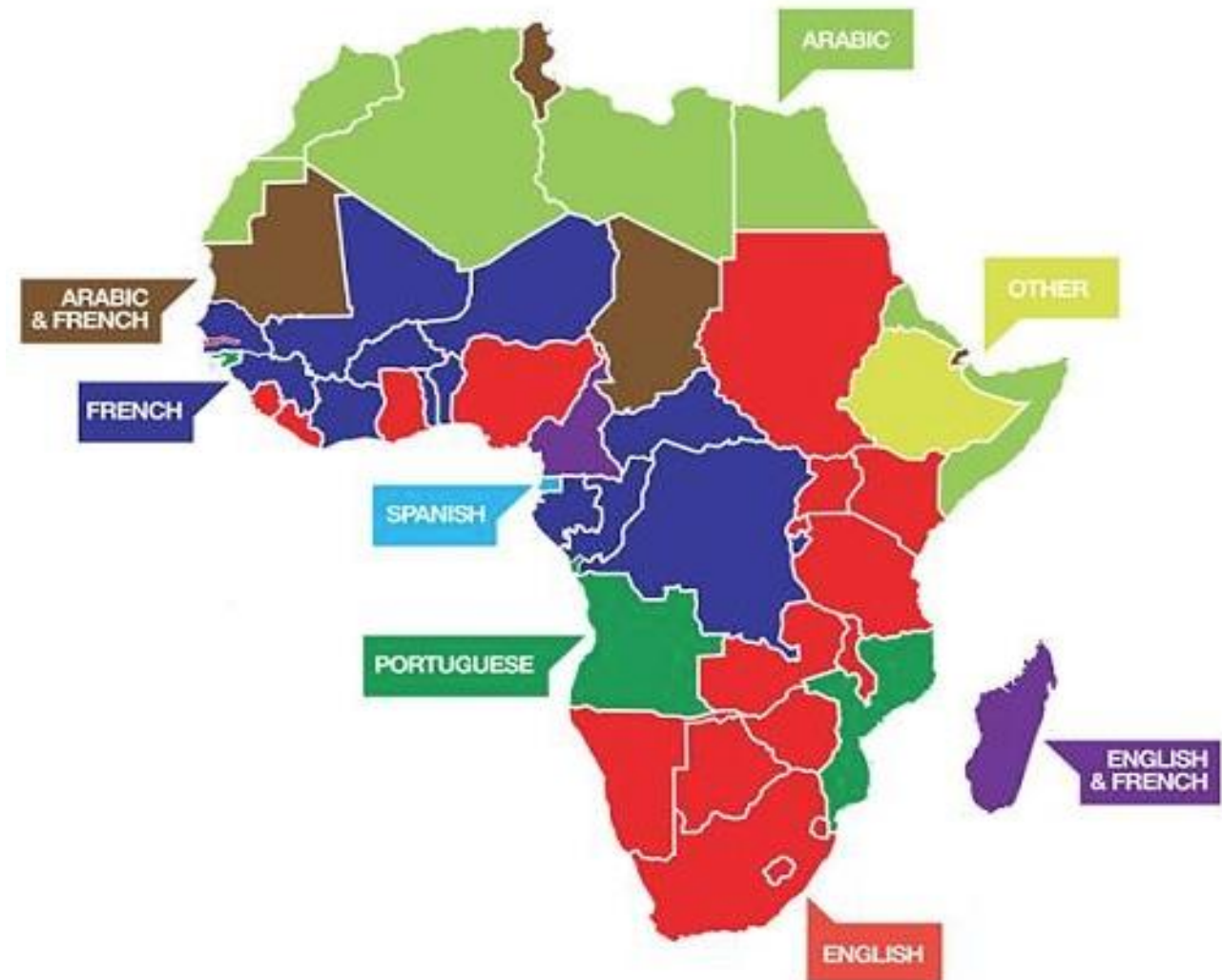


Internet Users By Region

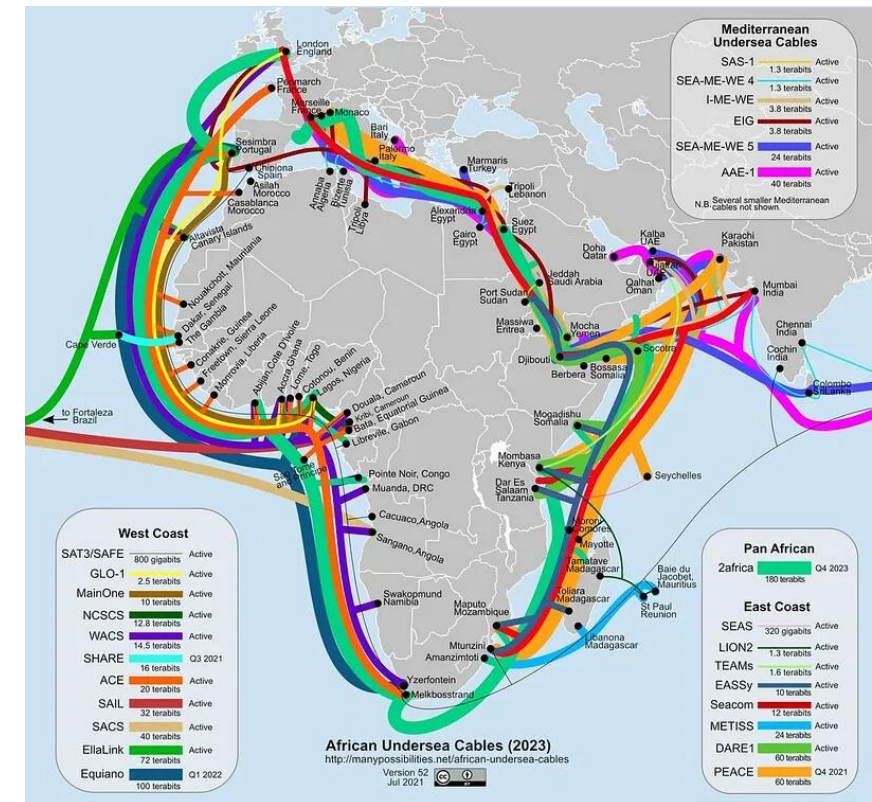
